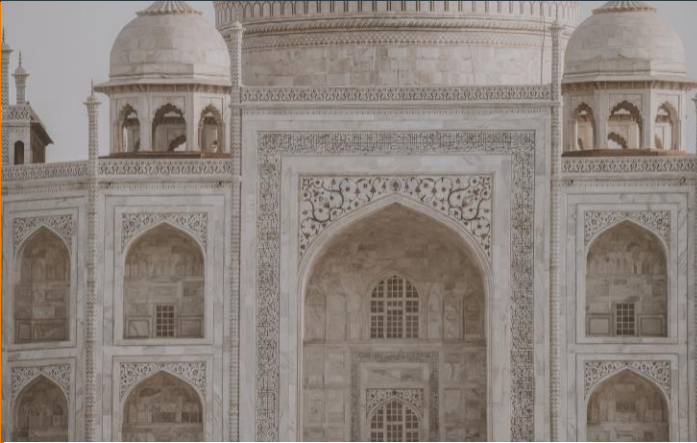

MARCH 2025

Mar 12 – Wed: Kochi – Delhi – Jaipur

Board morning flight from Kochi airport to Delhi...Meet on arrival at Delhi airport and straight drive to Jaipur and check-in at hotel. Overnight at hotel Meals: No meals

Mar 13 - Thu: Jaipur (HOLI Festival)

After breakfast, enjoy a half-day sightseeing tour of Jaipur visiting Amber Fort, located 11km from Jaipur, it was the old fort of the Kachwaha clan of Amber. The fort is built with white marble and red sandstone and looks even more attractive because of the Maota Lake in the foreground. The fort itself is a beautiful sight to behold.

Optional: Walking tour to explore various artisans of Jaipur

Optional: Culinary Delight Tour - Learn the secrets of Indian cuisine and try your hand at cooking local dishes with Indian family, with dinner included. Overnight at hotel Meals: Breakfast only

Mar 14 - Fri: Jaipur (HOLI Festival)

After breakfast, we will transfer you to the venue for "Holi celebrations" where you will enjoy participating in Holi festivities with lots of fun dancing on local music, play with Colours, water with fellow travellers as well as other travellers from various parts of the world.

In the afternoon you will return back to your hotel Overnight at hotel Meals: Breakfast only

Mar 15 - Sat: Jaipur – Agra

(By surface: 250 Kms/5 Hours)

After breakfast check-out and drive to Agra. On the way, you will visit Chand Baori Step Well, located opposite a temple known as Harshat Mata Temple. It is believed that the Chand Baori step well has a religious connection and that's the reason it was built in front of the temple.

On arrival to Agra, check into the hotel. Evening at leisure to explore the local markets Overnight at hotel Meals: Breakfast only

Mar 16 – Sun: Agra – Delhi

(By surface: 200 Kms/4 Hours)

SUNRISE: Today you will rise early and visit the Taj Mahal just after sunrise at approx. 6:00am Persian and earlier Mughal architecture. While earlier Mughal buildings were primarily constructed of red sandstone, Shah Jahan promoted the use of white marble inlaid with semi-precious stones. The Taj Mahal was commissioned by Shah Jahan in 1631, to be built in memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal. Construction of the Taj Mahal began in 1632, the principal mausoleum was completed in 1643 and the surrounding buildings and garden were finished about five years later.

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Delhi – Jaipur – Agra - Delhi

Later this afternoon enjoy a visit to Agra Fort (Red Fort) a fascinating sight, it showcases a high level of ornamentation and the Kohinoor diamond was reportedly part of the furnishings. The fort's artwork mixes Persian, European and Indian art, resulting in a unique Shahjahani style rich in form, expression and colour. Red Fort is one of the building complexes of India encapsulating a long period of history, arts and its innovative architectural style, including its garden design which influenced later buildings and gardens in Delhi. In 2007, it was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site as part of the Red Fort Complex.

After lunch (on direct payment), drive to Delhi and check-in at hotel

Overnight at hotel Meals: Breakfast only

Mar 17 – Mon: Delhi

Start your day with visit of Old Delhi or Shahjanbad -the city built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan who shifted the Mughal capital here from Agra in the 17th century. Drive along the river Yamuna past the magnificent Red Fort to one of the largest and most beautiful mosques in the world, the Jama Masjid. Enjoy a cycle rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk, the spine of Old Delhi, past jewelers spice merchants, food vendors, shopping arcades.

Later proceed to New Delhi visiting the Qutab Minar Complex, visiting a myriad of monuments that combine both Islamic calligraphy and Hindu motifs, commemorating the onset of Islamic rule in India. Continue to "Lutyen's" New Delhi, drive past the Rashtrapati Bhawan, (President's Palace), Secretariat Buildings, Parliament House and the India Gate, a war memorial arch built in honor of soldiers who died in the Afghan Wars and World War-I.

Overnight at hotel Meals: Breakfast only

Mar 18 – Tue: Depart Delhi
