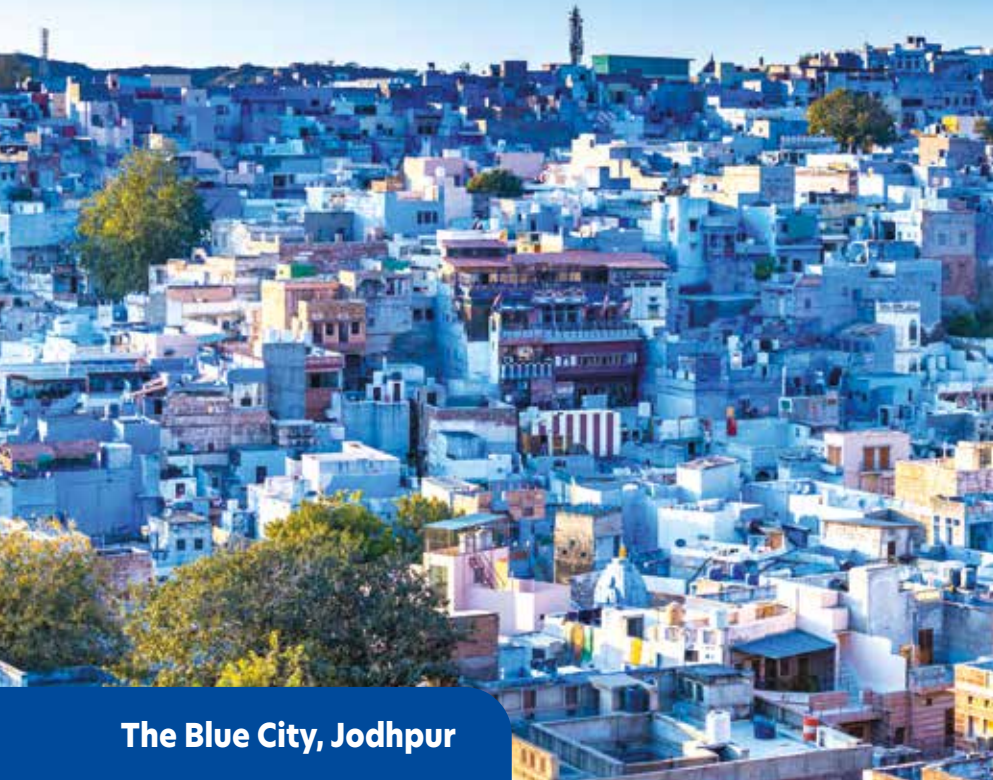

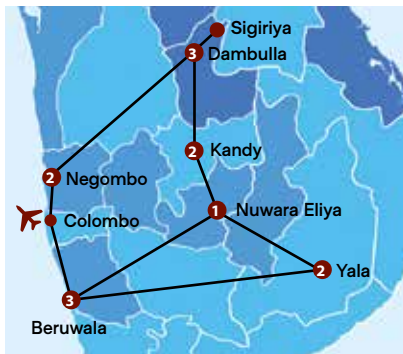

This tour combines culture and relaxation, taking in some of Sri Lanka's finest historical, archaeological and natural treasures, tea plantations, local experiences, shopping and the pleasures of a few days by the sea. ### Day 1: Arrive Colombo

On arrival at the airport, meet your tour Manager at the arrival lounge who will assist with the transfer to the Negombo hotel. Stay for two nights in Negombo.

Wake up early for a yoga session. Explore Dambulla's largest vegetables and fruits wholesale market. The harvest from the surrounding fields and villages is brought into the market for distribution to the rest of the country. Later we travel to a nearby organic farm to uncover the secrets

of Sri Lankan recipes with a hands-on cooking class. Learn to cook a few Sri Lankan dishes like meat, vegetable and a traditional salad. Subsequently, enjoy a traditional lunch along with the dishes you have prepared.

### Day 5: Excursion Sigiriya & Minneriya National Park (B) (D)

Discover the 5th century ancient cliff-top fortress of Sigiriya, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. These imposing citadel sites are known as "Lion's Rock" and explore the ruins of ancient palaces, moats, shrines, frescoes and water gardens as you take in commanding vistas of the misty forests beyond. Afternoon proceed for a wildlife safari at Minneriya National Park. The Park is based largely around a huge tank (reservoir) and serves as an important gathering place for Sri Lanka's large elephant population. Besides elephants, Minneriya is also

home to many species of mammals like the sambar deer and sloth bear.

**Day 6: Dambulla – Kandy** B D

Today we travel to Kandy, en-route visit Matale Spice Plantation where you can see how herbs and spices are grown in their natural environment. Learn their medicinal value and use in Sri Lankan cuisine to enhance the taste of speciality meals. Later travel to Kandy and walk around the Royal Botanical Gardens of Peradeniya, these gardens have a long history dating back to the British Era. Now the garden houses thousands of beautiful plant species brought from around the world. Stay two nights in Kandy.

**Day 7: Kandy** B D

by boat to the park headquarters and explore wildlife around the area. Enjoy lunch at the canteen and then continue to National Park. This Park is one of the best places in Sarawak to see wildlife in a natural setting and home of Borneo endemic proboscis monkeys, silvered langurs, long-tailed macaques, wild boar, monitor lizards and numerous species of birds. The Park also has an impressive range of mangrove to kerangas (heath forest), tropical swamp vegetation, cliff vegetation and beach vegetation.

**Day 04: Rainforest Kayaking** B L

After an early breakfast, proceed to Bengoh, the starting point of your kayak adventure. Float down a river that meanders through spectacular limestone hills clad with tropical rainforest and punctuated with Class 1 to Class 2 rapids providing a thrilling water ride. Visit a friendly Bidayuh Village, have a swim in the cool refreshing mountain water and enjoy a light picnic lunch on the sandy riverbank.

**Day 05: Kuching - Nanga Sumpa** B L D

Today after an early breakfast, drive to Batang Ai reservoir. Along the way stop for lunch and stroll around the shops at Lachau Bazaar. Board a local longboat and travel upriver to the Iban village. Afternoon, free to explore and evening visit Nanga Sumpa longhouse. Relax on the ruai (common verandah) and spend time with the Iban people. Interact with the community, learn about their culture, and enjoy some local rice wine. Stay two nights at Nanga Sumpa lodge.

**Day 06: Excursion to Enseluai waterfall** B L D

Today after breakfast, hike the jungle trails along the river for about an hour to another longhouse, then Board a local longboat and travel upriver to the Enseluai waterfall. Relax, swim and enjoy the rainforest surroundings and a riverside BBQ lunch. Later return to

the lodge and spend rest of the day in leisure.

**Day 07: Nanga Sumpa - Kuching** B L

After breakfast, travel downriver by boat to the Batang Ai Lake jetty followed by overland transfer to Kuching. The remaining afternoon is free to relax and stay overnight in Kuching.

**Day 8: Kuching - Mulu NP Deer & Lang Caves** B D

Transfer to Kuching airport to board a flight to Mulu National Park. On arrival, transfer to your accommodation. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic 3 km plank walk through the primary rainforest to the entrance of the famous Deer Cave. Later, visit the Lang's Cave famous for the stalactites and stalagmites followed by Bat Observatory known for a spectacular exodus of about 2 million bats leaving the cave in search of food. Return to the park accommodation and stay two nights in Mulu National Park.

**Day 9: Clearwater & Wind Caves** B L D

Today, proceed by longboat upriver to Wind Cave famous for its impressive 'King's Chamber', stalactites and stalagmites. Then to Clearwater Cave, a habitat for unique species of plants. Enjoy a picnic lunch, swim, or relax before returning. The rest of the afternoon is free for your leisure and in evening meet for the farewell dinner.

**Day 10: Mulu Departure** B

After breakfast, tour finishes with a transfer to the Mulu airport where you board a flight for your onward journey.

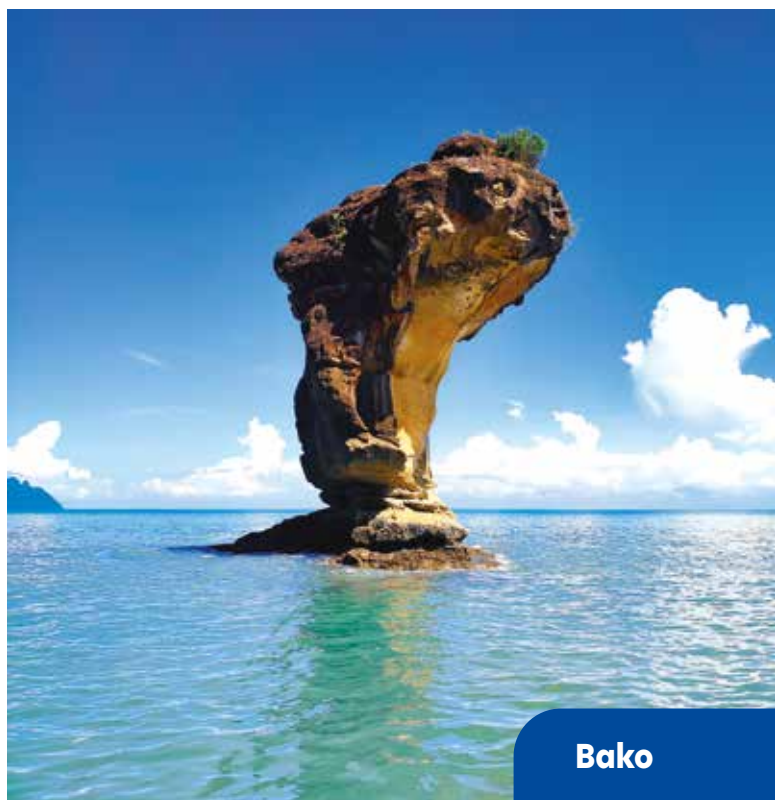
